Course Description and Target Audience

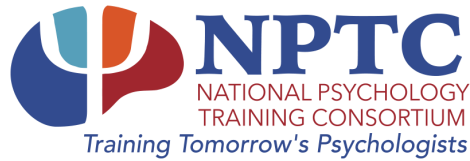
