Its expanding range of services includes family therapy, marital counseling, adolescent and children's counseling, autism services, alcohol and substance use treatment, individual and group therapy, skills coaching, hypnotherapy, transitional living, inpatient services, primary health care, and more. The Center accepts many insurance plans including Medicare and Medicaid and uses a sliding fee discount scale for patients that pay privately.

Sometimes they can adversely affect our quality of life and counseling can help.

If you have never been to counseling, you may be uncertain how it all works. If you have been to counseling in the past, there is a strong likelihood the procedures will be different.

Our Approach

During a therapy session, counselors work with patients to reach goals they establish together. These goals will be determined during the therapy sessions. Don't worry if you are unsure of what you want to accomplish. We will talk about it during the sessions.

The counselor's role is to support and coach their patients through mental and emotional struggles just as a coach helps players create strategies that they execute and modify in the game.
