Once licensed and fully credentialed, this individual will become part of the training committee and provide supervision to interns at Aspire.

## Blank Children's Hospital UnityPoint Health

### Blank Children's Hospital – Iowa

**Positions Available:** postdoctoral fellowship

**Training Opportunities:** Blank Children's Hospital is recruiting for a one-year Postdoctoral Fellow to join the Psychological Services Department. As part of the Blank Children's Developmental Center, the psychology team specializes in diagnostic evaluation and management of autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD).

UnityPoint Health is an integrated health system providing care throughout Iowa, western Illinois, and southern Wisconsin in not-for-profit hospitals, clinics, and home health settings. Blank Children's Hospital is an entity of UnityPoint Health housing over 15 pediatric specialties and is one of the top children's hospitals in Iowa. The Blank Children's Developmental Center (one of two in the state of Iowa) is located in West Des Moines, a short drive from the Blank Children's Hospital main campus. We are co-located with the STAR Center, which provides child advocacy and support for children who are drug-endangered, in foster care, and/or require support in growth and nutrition. Our state-of-the-art center was built in 2020 and has an array of services available. The postdoc may choose from a variety of activities for their experience.

The primary focus of the postdoctoral position will be pediatric outpatient evaluations for autism spectrum disorder and developmental disabilities (e.g., intellectual disability, global developmental delay), and ruling out secondary concerns such as attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, anxiety disorders, depression, and mood concerns. Referral sources include specialty and general pediatric clinics from across the state of Iowa. Inpatient consultations on pediatric units and pediatric specialty units are possible if desired. This is a primarily clinical position, though there is support for interests in training and research. The postdoc will join an established group of two psychologists and two psychometrists and partner closely with developmental pediatrics, therapists of all types (e.g., occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech therapy, applied behavior analysis), and social work.

The postdoc will receive training in gold standard autism measures (e.g., ADOS-2, CARS-2), cognitive assessments (e.g., Wechsler batteries), behavioral and socioemotional assessments (e.g., BASC-3, BRIEF-2), and adaptive assessments and interviews (e.g., ABAS-3, Vineland-3). The postdoc will receive training and supervision in case conceptualization, interview/preliminary assessment, and report writing. They will also receive training in interpersonal skills related to working with families and children with developmental disabilities and providing diagnostic feedback to families (e.g., communicating results, supporting families throughout the diagnostic process, reviewing recommendations). The postdoctoral fellow will have the opportunity to work in an interdisciplinary clinic with our developmental-behavioral providers (board-certified developmental-behavioral pediatricians and nurse practitioners) as well as

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other specialties as desired. Fellows will also be given the opportunity to give presentations for national, state, and local community organizations. The postdoctoral fellow will obtain competency in these areas to practice independently while having the ability to consult and gain supervision for licensure.

Our center is growing every year. We plan to pilot intensive outpatient services for the assessment and treatment of severe challenging behavior in children with ASD and I/DD. The interested postdoctoral fellow can gain experience in conducting experimental functional analyses, function-based treatments, complex behavior management, and parent training/generalization. Postdocs with interest in this area can gain supervision for both psychology licensure and board certification as a behavior analyst (BCBA).

The ideal candidate will possess exceptional clinical skills in the assessment and treatment of children and adolescents, including experience with autism and neurodevelopmental disorders. The position will provide postdoctoral clinical hours and supervision needed for licensure.

### **Requirements:**

- Full completion of doctoral degree by the beginning of the postdoctoral fellowship Successful completion of APA-accredited internship
- Licensed or license eligible in the state of Iowa
- Must be provisionally licensed in the state of Iowa and working toward Iowa Licensed Psychologist and Iowa Health Service Psychologist.
- Prior experience working in pediatric assessment and developmental disabilities is preferred but not required. Prior experience in applied behavior analysis is preferred but not required.
