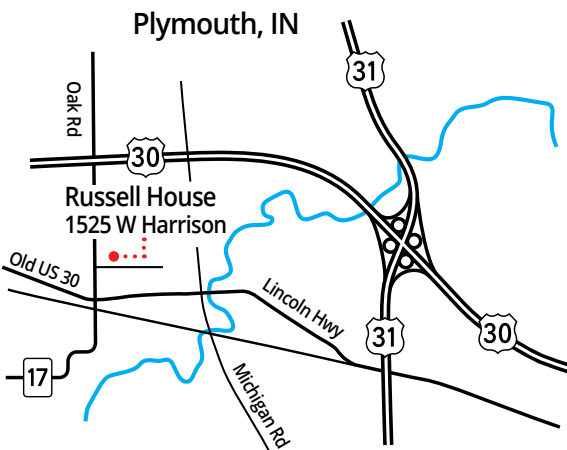
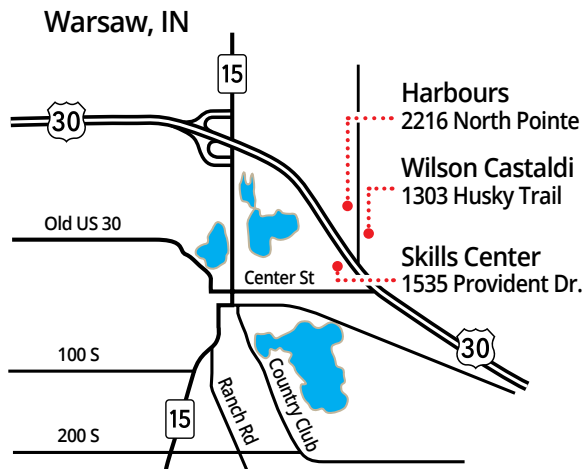

The Center now serves Indiana treating patients in-person, by phone or video conference with emotional health care, substance use treatment and with primary health care clinics located in Warsaw and Fort Wayne, IN.

Bowen Center's dedicated staff provides life-changing care to individuals, children and families. Its expanding range of services includes family therapy, marital counseling, adolescent and children's counseling, autism services, alcohol and substance use treatment, individual and group therapy, skills coaching, hypnotherapy, transitional living, inpatient services, primary health care, and more. The Center accepts many insurance plans including Medicare and Medicaid and uses a sliding fee discount scale for patients that pay privately.

TRANSITIONAL LIVING FACILITIES

Every Transitional Living facility offers:

- Transitional living is a short-term, time-limited treatment program
- On-site evidence-based treatments including: Dialectical Behavior Therapy, Illness Management and Recovery, and Solutions for Wellness
- Medication evaluation & monitoring
- Building social supports & community involvement
- Whole Health Wellness education and support
- Diagnosis and treatment of Serious Mental Illness diagnoses
- Inpatient Crisis Intervention & Stabilization
- Case Management & Care Coordination
- Ongoing Assessment & Evaluation
- Individual & Group Skills Training

Transitional Living pre-screening Reference Guide:

- Primary diagnosis of SMI
- If secondary diagnosis of ID/DD, BDDS application has been completed prior to Transitional Living referral
- Income-for per diem- if the patient has a payee, both must be willing to sign financial agreement
- Medicaid or eligible for Medicaid-application has been completed prior to referral for Transitional Living otherwise self pay
- Patient cannot qualify for assisted living or nursing home placement
- Patient cannot be on oxygen
- Patient cannot have medical needs that require assistance beyond prompting
- No sexual perpetration criminal record
- If criminal record of physical or domestic violence, an explanation required and a determination will be made
- Patient must be willing to engage in Transitional Living services

- 15 bed facility, individual and shared rooms
- 24/7 on-site staff
- Medication monitoring

Russell House Plymouth, IN (HUD)

- 10 bed facility, individual rooms
- 24/7 on-site staff
- Medication monitoring

Harbours Warsaw, IN

- 12 bed facility, individual and shared rooms
- 24/7 on-site staff
- Medication monitoring

Wilson Castaldi Apts Warsaw, IN

- 20 1-bedroom individual apartments
- HUD-subsidized affordable rent
- Staff on-site 7 days/week
